

Seven Steps to Homework Success

Communicate with Teachers

- Meet early in the school year
- Find out about grading periods
- Review homework policy
- Discuss classroom and learning expectations

Designate a Study Place

- Pick a quiet place with limited distractions
- Set a regular time and be consistent
- Provide supplies and resources

Provide Guidance and Support

- Understand your role
- Respect your child's learning style
- Review assignments together
- Utilize a calendar

Check for Understanding

- Discuss assignments
- Offer feedback
- Quiz your child and give practice tests
- Play study games and use flashcards

Show an Interest

- Read with your child
- Discuss school and learning activities daily
- Participate in school activities
- Get to know classmates and parents

Use Positive Reinforcement

- Give praise and encouragement
- Use a reward-based motivation system
- Celebrate victories

Notice Struggles

- Observe signs of frustration
- Ask questions
- Meet with your child's teacher
- Don't hesitate to use outside help
